**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AVOID LIEN ON
HOUSEHOLD AND PERSONAL GOODS HELD BY (CREDITOR NAME)**

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on debtor's motion to avoid lien of (*creditor name*), and the Court having considered the pleadings and documentation on file herein, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, FINDS:

1. A notice of deadline for filing objections to the motion to avoid lien of (*creditor name*) was filed and mailed requiring an objection be filed with the Court and served on debtor's attorney within 20 days of the mailing date of (*date*).
2. The deadline for filing objections expired (*date*).
3. No objections have been received.
