

Stay Relief

The following procedures apply to stay motions before Judge Jacobvitz:

1. The moving party must request a hearing from chambers staff before a hearing will be set.
2. If the movant serves notice of the motion specifying an objection period, the Court ordinarily will not set a hearing on the motion until an objection is filed. Alternatively, if the motion recites that the debtor, and case trustee, if any, have been contacted and either of them opposes the motion, the movant instead of serving notice of the motion specifying an objection period may contact chambers staff when the motion is filed to request a hearing, and then send notice of the hearing to all parties entitled to notice.
3. Ordinarily a preliminary hearing will be set on a stay motion, and the final hearing will be scheduled during the preliminary hearing.
