CONSUMER CLAIMANTS COMMITTEE'S OBJECTION TO MOTION TO DISMISS
AND COUNTER-MOTION TO CONVERT CASE TO CHAPTER 7

The official Consumer Claimants' Committee of the Quick Cash, Inc. bankruptcy estate (the "Consumer Committee"), by counsel, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1112(b), hereby objects to the *Motion to Dismiss* filed June 30, 2017 (Doc. No. 288) (the "Motion to Dismiss") filed by the debtor Quick Cash, Inc. (the "Debtor") and moves the Court to convert the above-captioned bankruptcy case to a case under chapter 7. As grounds for and in support of this

- 1. Under 11 U.S.C. § 1112(b)(1), "on the request of a party in interest, and after notice and a hearing, the court shall convert a case under this chapter to a case under chapter 7 or dismiss a case under this chapter, whichever is in the best interests of creditors and the estate, for cause unless the court determines that the appointment under section 1104(a) of a trustee or an examiner is in the best interests of creditors and the estate."
- 2. Cause exists to convert or dismiss this bankruptcy case under § 1112, including substantial and continuing diminution of the estate, failure to pay administrative expenses over a prolonged period, and lack of any reasonable likelihood of reorganization under chapter 11.
- 3. Conversion to chapter 7, and not dismissal, is in the best interests of creditors because it would enable a chapter 7 trustee to pursue the claims raised in Adv. 17-1051-j for the benefit of the estate.

WHEREFORE, the Consumer Committee requests that the Motion to Dismiss be denied, that this Court convert the above-captioned bankruptcy case to a case under chapter 7 of the bankruptcy code, and for such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.
