ORDER TERMINATING ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINES AND FIXING EXTENSION PERIOD

On December 21, 2018, the Court entered an Order Extending Deadlines Applicable to United States Governmental Units During Government Shutdown ("Order"). *See* Court Administrative Matters, No. 18-01 – Docket No. 7. The Order extended the deadlines applicable to various governmental agencies including the Department of Justice, the Office of the United States Trustee, and the United States Attorney's offices in the event of a partial shutdown of the United States Government ("Partial Shutdown"). For all matters pending in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Mexico, the Order extended any and all deadlines imposed by the Bankruptcy Code, the Rules, the Local Rules or by an order of this Court that apply to a governmental unit of the United States for the same number of business days as the Partial Shutdown. The Order provided further that the Court will enter a supplemental order terminating the extension and specifying the number of days deadlines were extended by the Order. The Partial Shutdown lasted from December 22, 2018 through January 31, 2019, a period of twenty-six business days.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Order is terminated

2. The deadlines extended pursuant to the Order were extended for twenty-six days.
